History:



In 1994, a group of believers started meeting outside of Karlsruhe, Germany, with the desire to start a new fellowship. They started small, renting a part of a hall above a karate school. Year by year they rented more space, as they expanded, until in 2004 they were able to purchase an old tobacco warehouse.

Located in the southern German province of Platz, Landau is a suburb of Karlsruhe, a local industrial center. The new property is located a 5- minute walk from the city center, in the middle of an area of apartment complexes. The neighborhood is a mix of old and new, young and old, native Germans and recent immigrants. The building has two full floors, at 4000 square feet a floor, plus the possibility of a youth space in the attic.

The purpose of the building is to house the local church, the Body of believers. They hope to use the facilities as a center for outreach, hosting Teaching English as a Foreign Language courses and other events.

Description of Work:

By October of 2005, the main structure was completed: walls, floors, stairs, plumbing and electrical layout. What the property needs now is finish work: hung ceiling, tiling of walls and floors, sheet rocking (including tape and bedding) and painting. Once the surfaces are completed, the fixtures (lights, kitchen cabinets and counters, toilets, etc.) will need to be installed.

After 2005-6, the landscaping and parking will need to be finished, as well as the attic.
