History:



The Greek Bible Institute, founded by Greater Europe Mission in 1973, is the only full time, interdenominational Bible College in Greece. The current property was built for the school in the early 1990's, with dormitories, library, classroom, and chapel on a beautiful campus. It is located in the town of Pikermi, located half way between Athens (the capital) and Marathon (where the Greeks defeated Darius and the Persian army).

All classes at the school are taught in Greek, to train Greek-speaking believers to be pastors, missionaries, and productive Christians. Many of their graduates are today's current church leaders in Greece.

Description of Work:

In the early 2000's, the school was able to construct the concrete shell of a new building. It needs to be finished out: electrical, plumbing, drywall, tiling, etc....

They plan to use the building for library and classroom space.

Teams would live and eat on campus, when school is out of session.
